Welcome to Eidsvoll and the history of the Norwegian Constitution



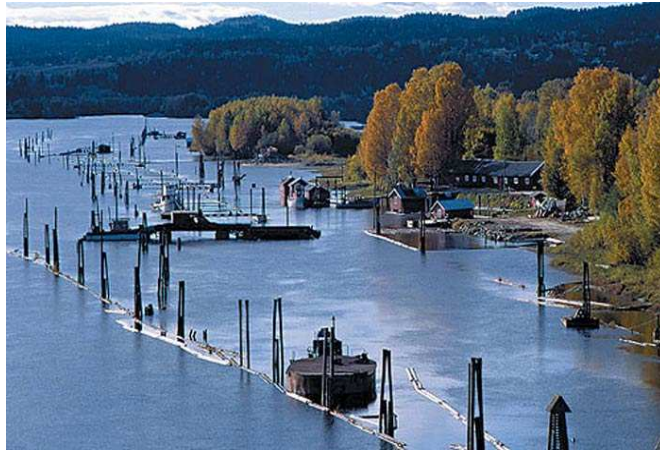

Take a Journey back in time in Eidsvoll bygningen (The Eidsvoll manor) , one of the most famous national monuments In Norway.

The Norwegian Constitution was ratified on the 17th of May 1814.

Fetsund Lenser

Fetsund Lenser includes a National Heritage Memorial, a Timber floating museum, and a Nature information centre.



They offer a unique blend of culture and nature adventures, set in a beautiful scenery by the river Glomma and the Nordre Øyeren nature reserve at the largest inland delta of northern Europe. Norway's only preserved timber sorting and bundling facility, now a national heritage monument.

Losby Gods

Losby Gods is set in an area of natural beauty offering a broad variety of outdoor activities and recreation. The manor's main attraction is the golf course, driving range and tennis courts.

Losby's history stems from the mid-19th-century to today's modern hotel experience. Losby Gods is just 20 minutes from the centre of Oslo and half an hour from Gardemoen. The hotel has 70 rooms, function rooms, a bar, an indoor golf centre and a variety of meeting facilities of different sizes.



Lillestrøm Kultursenter

The new Culture Centre opened in 2007, with a total area of 7000 sqm.
